Monaco 18th August 2007

According to Resolution MSC.195 (80), as from 1st January 2009, the Document of Compliance and the Safety Management Certificate (interim and full term) shall mention the Company's identification number.

All companies are required to obtain an identification number prior to the scheme coming into force on 01 January and submit it to this Administration (Monaco@svg-marad.com or technical@svg-marad.com).

From the 01 January 2009 mentioned certificates when newly issued will have the IMO unique company identification number inserted.

Monaco, 12th August 2008.

According to Resolution MSC.196 (80), as from 1st January 2009, the International Ship Security Certificate (interim and full term) shall mention the Company's identification number.

In order for this Resolution to be implemented as early as possible and to avoid possible delay, it is recommended for the ships to be in possession of these certificates prior 1st January 2009.

The ships which are not in possession of an International Ship Security Certificate as per Resolution MSC.196 (80) are urged to submit the company's identification number to this Administration (monaco@svg-marad.com or technical@svg-marad.com) so that the International Ship Security Certificate can be re-issued. The cost of this re-issue will be US\$ 100.00.
