# DETENTIONS OF VESSELS INSIDE THE PARIS MOU REGION (PARTICULARLY IN ITALY)

TO: SHIPOWNERS & SHIPS' OPERATORS & MANAGERS SURVEYORS TO FLAG STATE ADMINISTRATION

**APPLICABLE TO:** ALL SHIPS CALLING ITALY AND THE PARIS MOU

**ENTRY INTO FORCE: ISSUING DATE OF PRESENT CIRCULAR** 

Monaco, 01 Oct. 06.

We refer to the Circular N° PSC 003.

The analysis of the evolution of ST VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES Flag ships detentions inside the Paris MOU Region shows an improving situation which complies with this Administration's policy to improve vessels' safety and enforce the application of International Conventions.

The Paris MOU Committee, during its 39<sup>th</sup> meeting in June 2006, considered the 2005 inspection results and adopted the new Black – Grey – White List which took effect on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006.

St Vincent and the Grenadines Flag is now in Medium to High Risk (mthr).

The above means that, the following will be effective as from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006:

- When a St Vincent and the Grenadines Flag vessel's target factor will be calculated, the points attributed will be 8.
- According to Paris Memorandum on Port Ste Control, Section 3, paragraph 3.10.5 (Access refusal measures concerning certain ships), the refusal of access order will be issued if the St Vincent and the Grenadines Flag vessel has been detained more than twice in the course of the preceding 24 months in ports of the Memorandum.

The improving situation has been obtained by the efforts and commitments of many Shipowners having their vessels flying St Vincent and the Grenadines Flag and by this Administration.

## **During 2005:**

- Italy, for seven consecutive years, has been the leading Country among the Paris MOU's members in terms of number of inspections and detentions (all Flags).
- This Administration obtained significant results in Italy.

Italian Port State Control average detention ratio, all Flags, is 9.95%.

Shipowners and this Administration should increase their efforts and commitments to further improve the Flag performances in Italy.
