During PSC Inspections GMDSS Officers should be fully familiarized with the GMDSS equipment and tests and should be able to answer the following questionnaire:

- 1. Demonstrate daily/weekly test on DSC's
- 2. Demonstrate how undesignated distress alert is sent on VHF, MF/HF DSC's
- 3. Demonstrate how designated distress alert is sent on VHF, MF/HF DSCs
- 4. Explain how you will cancel a false distress alert sent on VHF DSC, including channel and message
- 5. Explain how you will cancel a false distress alert sent on MF/HF DSC, including frequency and message
- 6. Demonstrate how you will send an undesignated distress alert using the INMARSAT C terminal.
- 7. Explain which action you will take to cancel a false distress alert on INMARSAT C
- 8. Demonstrate how you will send a designated distress alert on INMARSAT C.
- 9. Explain how the EPIRB activates automatically and precautions to be taken to prevent false alerts.
- 10. Explain how to manually activate the EPIRB.
- 11. Explain the procedure to cancel false alert sent on the EPIRB.
- 12. Explain routine checks and tests to be carried out on the EPIRB
- 13. Explain how to activate a SART.
- 14. Explain the routine checks and tests to be carried out on the SART.
- 15. Explain which action should be taken if the SART is interrogated when in the life raft.
- 16. Enumerate the daily/weekly and monthly tests/checks to be carried out as per GMDSS Regulations
- 17. Fully explain how the GMDSS Radio Log should be maintained
- 18. Explain test and routine checks to be carried out on the GMDSS hand held radio (walkie-talkie).
